Everything you need to know to make the units required for this block can be found in the instructions that came with the Rapid Fire* Lemoyne Star, Large Square Squared*, and Corner Beam* tools, and the Stacked Squares and Blazing Lemoyne Stars technique sheets. There are charts, step-by-step graphics, and directions. Use the charts to find the information you need for the finished size units you want to make; follow it through to find what you need to cut to make those units. Then work your way through the instructions.


The combination of Blazing Lemoyne Star quadrants with traditional units makes this block unique. Select fabrics that have good contrast so that each part of the block stands out. You will want to pay attention when making your Blazing Lemoyne quadrants. You will work your way through the Blazing Lemoyne Star technique sheet to step 6, where you sew your pairs of star points together. Once you sew your pairs together you will trim the Lemoyne Star quadrants using the Tucker Trimmer* I to the size designated in the chart on the following page. Remember, you have already trimmed the "center point" sides of the Blazing Lemoyne quadrant, so the only trim you need to make is on the "outside edge" sides. For these blocks, I did use mirror image units, which means that you would need to make an "A" and "B" section in each color to recreate that look.

You can also substitute any of the Lemoyne Star technique sheets for the Blazing Lemoyne Star and come up with a completely different look for this block. Just stop at the point where you sew the pairs of star points together and trim the quadrants according to the chart size. Keep in mind that you will still need to make mirror image "A" and "B" sections if you substitute another technique. This block really lends itself to experimentation, so have fun making Flaring Glimmer your own!




