

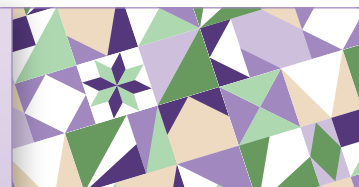

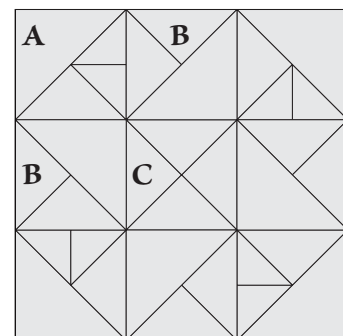

Everything you need to know to make the units required for this block can be found in the instructions that came with the **Tucker Trimmer® I** tool, and the Non Mirror Combo Units and Triangle Pizazz technique sheets. There are charts, step-by-step graphics, and directions. Use the chart to find the information you need for the finished size units you want to make, and follow it through to find what you need to cut to make those units. Then work your way through the instructions.

When making the non mirror image combo units, work through step 7 on the technique sheet. Then use two different colored squares for step 8, allowing you to make all four units at once. Try pressing the final seam open on the combo units and on the quarter square triangle units to reduce bulk.

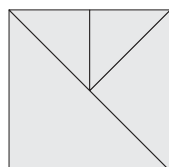
The Triangle Pizazz units are perfect to use your new First Choice™ rulers with. Use the dotted lines for step 6 of the technique, and the solid lines for step 7. Don't forget, there is a great tutorial video on YouTube for using your First Choice™ rulers.

This block is perfect for experimenting with color placement and value. Have fun making Twisted Barbs your own!

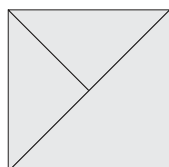

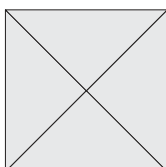
