

One-Block Wonder Jacket Workshop



Create a showstopping wearable from seven panels! Join Terri Butler of Mama Sid Sew, LLC for a hands-on workshop covering panel layout, precise piecing, garment construction, and professional finishing. Leave with a nearly finished jacket and clear next steps to complete it at home. (Quilting techniques not included.)



Who should attend

- Intermediate sewists comfortable with standard sewing machine operations and working with multiple fabric layers.

What participants will learn

- Jacket layout and designing around a foundation panel with hexagons cut from six additional panels.
- Garment assembly: Including tips on setting sleeves.
- Professional finishing: clean seams, edge finishes, and closures.

Fabric Requirements:

- OBW panels: 7 full panels. Size and shape matter so feel free to consult Terri Butler with panel dimensions for guidance: msaidsew@gmail.com.
- Coordinating solids or small prints for embellishing with Star 60 “Jewels”: 3–4 pieces — 1/4 to 3/4 yard each depending on use (trim, facings, accents, binding)
- Backing: Although there should be enough hexagons for a pieced backing, you may want to save them for another project and use yardage instead: 4 yards.
