

OBW 2.0 - Star 60 Jewelry Workshop

Are you ready to dive into the world of 60° quilting designs? Join Jackie & Terri and “Play Among the Stars”. Learn everything the Star 60 Tool has to offer, as shown in my quilt 60° Solar System.

This workshop focuses on designing and enhancing the *already cut out equilateral triangles & hexies stitched together* for a OBW quilt or jacket by adding stars and cubes made with the Star 60 tool. You may use Framed 60, Checkerboard 60, Striped 60, Capped 60, Hollow Cube 60, Quad 60, 60° Log cabin and Power Strip Technique Sheets. Also, combining different Star 60 units to create one of a kind stars. The hexagons below are constructed by combining different Star 60 units.

This workshop will focus on learning the different ways you can use the Star 60 technique sheets listed left. Adding stars/cubes of different sizes.

We will cover as many Star 60 techniques as time allows. You can bring OBW projects you want help with designing. This workshop is about creative design.

This hexagon requires the Wing Clipper 1 and Geese on the Edge Technique Sheet.



Fabric Requirements: This class focuses on many techniques. Fabrics can be fat quarters, 1/2 yards or whole yards.

- Left over hexies
- Fabric colors pulled from your OBW
- For cubes you need a light, medium and dark fabrics
- Bring a variety of fabrics. Stars can have as many as 6 different fabrics.
