Everything you need to know to make the units required for this block can be found in the instructions that came with the Four Patch Square Up®, Square Squared®, and V Block® tools. There are charts, step-by-step graphics, and directions. Use the chart to find the information you need for the finished size units you want to make. Follow it through to find what you need to cut to make those units. Then work your way through the instructions.

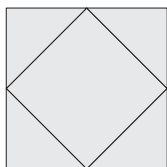
This is a straightforward block that will be easy to make. For the Four Patch units, try spinning the seams or pressing them open to reduce bulk. Pressing the seams open on the square squared units will also make it easier to match the seam intersections. Color placement in the V Block units gives the block a radiating effect, and using high contrast fabrics will make them stand out.

You can easily make this block your own with just a few simple changes. Try fussy cutting the center of the Square Squared units or making the Four Patch units scrappy to completely change the look.

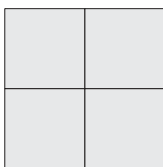

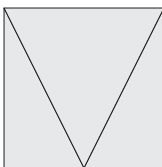
